Did you know?

Signs can sometimes be a last-minute consideration, but they can have a significant impact on the well-being of guests as well as the efficiency of the building. In our experience, getting them right means answering four key questions:

Can I see it?

Tip 1. Think about where you position signs and ensure clear sight lines. Consider complementary floor graphics to assist in navigation.

Can I read it? Is it clear?

Tip 2. A prime constraint on the legibility of a sign is the viewer's distance from it, and a simple relationship exists between the size of letters and the maximum distance from which a user can read them.

Can I understand it?

Tip 3. Combining pictures or photos and words can help patients better understand the instructions, avoiding frustrations and misunderstandings.

Do I trust the information?

Tip 4. Professional, quality signage and graphics give confidence to patients, visitors, and staff, support the hospital's brand or image and provide legitimacy to the signs, leaving visitors confident that they can trust the information given.
